# **REGISTRATION**

- Registration opens **1st March 2026**.
- Registration closes **31st July 2026**.
- Registration and competition are open to all members of a floral art society/national association represented in World Association Floral Artists and is subject to confirmation and receipt of payment.
- The registration, workshop and competition entry forms are available online at [www.wafaaustralia.com](http://www.wafaaustralia.com) in the downloadable **Registration Details brochure**.
- **You can enter only one class out of the 24 classes.**
- Registration and/or competition and/or workshop fees must be paid at the time of registration via direct bank deposit or online via the Credit Card link, in Australian Dollars.
- All delegates entering the competition or booking a workshop must register. This excludes competitors sending mail-in entries for Class No's 5, 11 & 12.

- Please type or print clearly to avoid errors and retain a copy of all forms for your records.
- Registrants will be notified of allocation of competition class and tickets by **31st August 2026**.
- Reconfirmation of competition entry is required by email no later than **30<sup>th</sup> September 2026**.
- Only paid registrants will be given access to events.
- Bank transfer fees are to be payable by the remitter.

## **WORKSHOPS & EVENTS**

- Workshop spaces are strictly limited and will be allocated on a first in basis. Workshop participants must pay the full registration fee.
- Workshop selection is to be completed on FORM C and submitted with FORM D.
- Seminar Reunion, Gala Dinner and Floral Extravaganza bookings for registered delegates are to be completed on FORM C and submitted with FORM D.
- If you wish to attend the Floral Extravaganza ONLY as a non-registered delegate, please complete the separate Floral Extravaganza Form and return to Barbara Griffiths: wafa2027registration@gmail.com with your payment notice.

## **BIOSECURITY**

- AUSTRALIA HAS STRICT BIOSECURITY LAWS WHICH MEANS BRINGING PLANT MATERIAL INTO THE COUNTRY IS EXTREMELY LIMITED. Please refer to the Australian Government website [www.bicon.agriculture.gov.au](http://www.bicon.agriculture.gov.au) for further information. However, we recommend you do not bring any horticultural material with you. The flower markets are relatively close to our venue.
- Parramatta City Council have strict rules regarding use of invasive weeds Please refer to the information on pages 18 and 19 in the competition schedule.
- The World Association of Floral Artists, World Association of Floral Artists Australian Management Committee or the Australian Floral Art Association take no responsibility for any action taken by Australian Customs & Quarantine should you choose to bring botanical materials into Australia.

## **INSURANCE & LIABILITY**

- You are responsible to arrange your own personal travel & health insurance. This insurance is mandatory to ensure you are fully protected for any unexpected medical emergencies, cancellations or property costs.
- The World Association of Floral Artists, Australian Floral Art Association and the World Association of Floral Artists Australia will not be liable for any loss arising due to change or cancellation of an event, of personal belongings and/or damage to property.

## **CANCELLATION POLICY**

- **Before 1st December 2026:** Payments made will be refunded via bank transfer (any applicable bank charges will be deducted from the refund amount).
- **Between 1st January and 1st February 2027:** Refunds will only be issued if your place is taken by another delegate.
- **After 1st February 2027 or in the event of non-attendance at the World Flower Show:** Any payments made are non-refundable.

## **TRAVEL & ACCOMMODATION**

- Airfares & accommodation are not included.

- Transfer to/from the Airport, your accommodation is not included. Public transport - train, ferry, bus, taxi or Uber are available.

You may only use hand-held cameras, without separate lighting, tripods or other supports. No photographs may be used commercially.

# GENERAL INFORMATION

Welcome to Australia! To help you prepare for your journey and enjoy your stay, here are some key points about travel, safety, and local conditions.

## ENTRY & VISA REQUIREMENTS

Visas are required for most international visitors to Australia.

Common options include the Electronic Travel Authority (ETA) or Visitor Visa, depending on your nationality and length of stay.

Apply online before travelling via the [Australian Government Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade](http://www.dfat.gov.au/travel) website. [www.dfat.gov.au/travel](http://www.dfat.gov.au/travel)

Ensure your passport is valid for at least six months beyond your intended stay.

## MEDICAL EMERGENCY

- Triple Zero (000) is Australia's national emergency number for police, fire, and ambulance. You will need to say which service you need with your location, the nature of the emergency and other details.
- From mobile phones, you can also dial 112, the international emergency number.
- Translators are available if you don't speak English.
- Australia also has a national telephone warning system (Emergency Alert) which sends text messages to mobile phones in affected areas during emergencies.

## HEALTH & SAFETY TIPS

- Sun safety: Australia has strong UV radiation. Wear sunscreen (SPF 50+), hats, and sunglasses. Stay hydrated by drinking plenty of water when spending a day in the sun.
- Swimming: At any beach only swim between the **red and yellow flags** where there are lifeguards on patrol. If there are no flags, don't go swimming.
- Be aware of natural hazards such as jellyfish, rips, crocodiles, and sharks in certain regions - generally far North Queensland.
- Remote travel: Carry adequate food, water, and communication devices if visiting rural or outback areas.
- Australia is considered a safe country with low crime rates, but exercise normal precautions with personal belongings.

## **WATER & FOOD SAFETY**

- Tap water is safe to drink throughout Australia. Bottled water is widely available if preferred.
- Food - hygiene standards are high, and restaurants and cafes are generally safe to enjoy.

## **CONNECTIVITY**

- International roaming works with most mobile providers.
- Free Wi-Fi is common in hotels, airports, and cafes.
- Emergency alerts and notifications will reach international travellers if their phone is roaming on an Australian network.

## **PRACTICAL INFORMATION**

Currency: Australian Dollar (AUD).

Power outlets: Type I plug, 230V supply.

Transport: Reliable domestic flights, trains, buses, ferries, taxis and ride-share services.

Language: English is the official language.
